### Types of Child Allowances

Child Support Allowance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A single-mother household or family with a father who has a severe level of disability, raising a child up to the first March 31st after the child reaches 18 years of age (19 years of age or younger for a child with a designated level of disability).</li> <li>Unable to receive a public pension</li> <li>Income amount must not exceed the designated ceiling</li> <li>The child is not institutionalized in a children's welfare facility</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Family register of the applicant and child</li> <li>Documentation showing the bank account of the applicant</li> <li>Income certificate Note: If you move into Machida City on or after January 2, you will need:</li> <li>Application between January and June—Income of the year before last</li> <li>Application between July and December—Income of the previous year</li> </ul>
Child-Raising Allowance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A single-parent household or family with a father or mother who has a severe level of disability, raising a child up to the first March 31st after the child reaches 18 years of age</li> <li>A family raising a child 19 years of age or younger with a designated level of disability</li> <li>The child is not institutionalized in a children's welfare facility</li> <li>Income amount must not exceed the designated ceiling</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Family register of the applicant and child</li> <li>Documentation showing the bank account of the applicant</li> <li>Income certificate Note: If you move into Machida City on or after January 2, you will need:</li> <li>Application between January and April—Income of the year before last</li> <li>Application between May and December—Income of the previous year</li> </ul>

## ● Medical Subsidies for Children

- **Medical Subsidies for Infants and Toddlers (Maru-Nyu Medical Treatment Card)**

The personally-borne expense for treatment with health insurance is subsidized when preschool infants and toddlers are treated at a medical institution.

**Eligibility:** Preschool infants and toddlers who live in Machida City, and are enrolled in some type of public health insurance. There are no restrictions as to the parent's income.

- **Medical Subsidies for School Children in Compulsory Education (Maru-Ko Medical Treatment Card)**

The personally-borne expense for treatment with health insurance is subsidized when school children in elementary or junior high school are treated at a medical institution (However, there is a personally-borne cost up to ¥200 for each outpatient visit).

**Eligibility:** School children in elementary or junior high school who live in Machida City, and are enrolled in some type of public health insurance. Income restrictions apply.

- **Medical Subsidies for Single-Parent Families (Maru-Oya Medical Treatment Card)**

This is a subsidy program for a single-parent household or family with a father or mother who has a severe level of disability, raising a child up to the first March 31st after the child reaches 18 years of age (19 years of age or younger for a child with a designated level of disability). The personally-borne cost upon receiving the subsidy is 10% for taxable households, and free for non-taxable households.

**Eligibility:** Those who live in Machida City, meet the abovementioned conditions, and are enrolled in some form of public health insurance. Income restrictions apply. Please note that those who receive public financial assistance are not eligible for this program.
